I will read it. 1 The Governor shall be responsible for the 2 faithful execution of the laws. 3 MR. MARTINEAU: I have one comment. 4 JUDGE ADKINS: This is one I thought would 5 6 get by without comment. MR. MARTINEAU: The reason I suggest that 7 is probably out of retaliation. The Commission amended 8 one section of the judiciary article where we referred 9 to laws by putting in by this Constitution or by law and 10 I wonder if it shouldn't also say here faithful 11 execution of the Constitution in the laws. 12 I would say no, because it JUDGE ADKINS: 13 seems to me the Constitution itself executes it. 14 MR. MARTINEAU: That is what you said. 15 That was exactly my point on which I lost. I am not 16 17 making a motion. THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question or 18 comment concerning 9(a). Section (b). 19 JUDGE ADKINS: The Governor may at any time 20 require information, in writing or otherwise, from officers 21
