that these sections would apply to the judicial department and administrative departments such as administrative offices of the courts?

No, sir, we did not have JUDGE ADKINS: that in mind. Our concept here was this was the executive and administrative offices of the executive branch of the government.

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't quarrel with the idea it should. As a matter of fact, they do now. The administrative office of the court is subject to the control of the Legislature. The Clerk of the Court are subject to control of the Legislature and the Comptroller. I wonder if you mean to exclude the administrative departments of the judicial branch from the operation of this provision.

JUDGE ADKINS: We did not specifically consider the administrative officer and the clerks. My view, the division of the powers, the administrative office of the court would be a matter for the Supreme Chief Justice of the Supreme Bench. It should not be a matter which would be subject to reorganization by the
