chief executive. In other words, I can conceive of a very definite conflict if the Governor had the right to reorganize the administrative office of the court.

THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I am not expressing an opinion. I don't see the difficulty but is not the language here capable of that interpretation that it would be applicable to the administrative offices within the other two departments of government?

JUDGE ADKINS: Well, our thought was that it was not but I gather it must be.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan.

MR. SCANIAN: I notice it is late in the day to be suggesting changes in the text but to offset the problem, the Chairman raised to make it perfectly clear the power is limited to agencies within the executive branch, you could strike the words executive and administrative appearing in the first line of (a) and then add the phrase within the executive branch to follow the phrase state government. The section would then read all offices, agencies and instrumentalities of state government within the executive branch, and
