

1 MR. SAYRE: No, I was thinking of a positive
2 rephrasing.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Let's not get the language
4 but the principle first.

5 MR. SAYRE: Which is on the principle.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: All right.

7 MR. SAYRE: All functions and duties that
8 fall within the responsibility of the executive depart-
9 ment.

10 MR. BOND: No, no.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: It doesn't help me. It
12 may help some of the others. I was going to suggest
13 that we, if we agreed on the question of principle that
14 we leave to the Committee and its reporter the matter
15 of working out the best phraseology to accomplish that.

16 MRS. BOTHE: I second it.

17 DR. BARD: So moved.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: All right, any further
19 question or comment with respect to Section (a)?

20 DR. JENKINS: I have a comment. The last
21 sentence in (c) is superfluous. What does this add?
