

1 JUDGE ADKINS: That the Legislature could
2 provide that an executive secretary, for example, of
3 the Racing Commission, would be appointed who would
4 be the chief administrator as opposed to the chief
5 policy maker of the board and would later provide that
6 the Governor shall have the power to hire and fire the
7 chief administrative officers thus set up.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question on

11 JUDGE ADKINS: The Governor shall appoint
12 all single executives serving as heads of principal
13 departments and all chief administrative officers
14 serving under boards or commissions which head principal
15 departments, except presidents of institutions of
16 higher education. These appointees shall have such
17 professional qualifications as may be prescribed by law
18 and shall serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

19 (b) The governor shall appoint the members
20 of all boards or commissions which serve as heads of
21 principal departments. The term of office of such
