

1 limitation should be. I think substantially most
2 us felt that three months was enough. We felt
3 that primarily because we recognized that this
4 convention will be meeting having the benefit of
5 fruits of the work of this Commission. They will
6 be writing on a blank tablet. Hopefully many of
7 recommendations will prove attractive to them. In
8 any event, all our recommendations should be of
9 benefit to them. Therefore, they will not be start
10 afresh in a sense. They can get down to the
11 business of recommending revisions in the constitution
12 without too much delay. Even the Michigan convention
13 didn't have the advantage of that type of pre-convention
14 preparation.

15 So there was strong sentiment that three
16 months would be enough. On the other hand, we
17 recognized that the convention may want to adjourn
18 from time to time in order to take testimony in
19 hearings. So we felt that the outside would be
20 months. Originally if we had our "druthers," we
21 like to see the convention assemble July 4, 1967.
