2 containing a list of what I assume to be all of the
3 offices you could think that would come under this
4 revised provision and it is a little difficult on
5 taking a hasty glance at it to know just how widespread
6 on an immediate practical basis the change would be.
7 For instance, I don't believe you indicate, maybe you
8 do, the length of terms of the various boards now.

9 JUDGE ADKINS: We do not. It is a little
10 difficult to answer your question because of the fact
11 that I don't know how many principal departments the
12 ultimate reorganization statute will result in. That
13 is a matter, as I said earlier, that is now under study.
14 The intent of this is to give the Governor the right
15 to appoint and to discharge at will the heads of the
16 principal departments. How many of those principal
17 departments there will be, I can't answer. It is
18 not our intent that he should be able to go below the
19 chief executive officer of each of the principal
20 departments. Now I would guess unquestionably there
21 would be perhaps health, perhaps law enforcement, and
