MRS. BOTHE: My question is directed to the question of tenure of appointment and the provision that upon ascending office the new Governor would have the right to replace at least 50 per cent of existing policy boards.

JUDGE ADXINS: I don't think that is the intent. The intent is that the phasing of appointments, which now can be staggered over a period of six years, would be staggered in such a way that at least 50 per cent of the board would be up for appointment every four years.

THE CHAIRMAN: During every period of four years.

JUDGE ADKINS: During every period of four years.

MRS. BOTHE: You say here taking office upon his election.

JUDGE ADKINS: This again would relate to the provisions for the appointment. It is not our intention that every time a new Governor goes in, he automatically fires half and appoints half. The
