

1 statutory legislation relating to the boards would be
2 so drawn that the terms of half of the members of the
3 board would expire coincident with the new Governor
4 taking office. It may be a distinction without a
5 difference.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan.

7 MR. SCANLAN: That was my question, Dale.
8 Do you intend that immediately upon taking office,
9 the appointments would be so prescribed by law that
10 at once he could, that the 50 per cent would go out
11 or is it your intention during his first term after
12 taking office he would be in position to replace 50
13 per cent?

14 JUDGE ADKINS: The terms of the boards
15 would be coincident with the gubernatorial term, so
16 coincident with the demise of the old chief executive,
17 at least half of the members of the board would go so
18 a new Governor taking office would have at least 50
19 per cent of his own appointees to each of the major
20 policy making boards.
