1 DR. BARD: My question has been asked. T 2 do want to get into the debate. THE CHARMAN: Mr. Della. 3 4 MR. DELLA: Judge, would this include in your recommendation the Workmen's Compensation Commission 5 6 also? 7 JUDGE ADKINS: The Workmen's Compensation Commission in our thinking would fall under paragraph 8 (c) of the quasi-judicial agency. 9 10 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question? 11 MR. CLAGETT: The executive secretary of 12 the Racing Commission reports to the Governor on the 13 status of various funds which have been built under 14 that Commission by law such as the Maryland Breed Fund, such as the Building Fund insofar as the tracks are 15 concerned and there is a difference between the operation 16 of that fund relating to the mile tracks as distinguished 17 from the half mile tracks. So the Governor should 18 19 have access to an appointive power or firing power over that individual because of the responsibility with 20 21 respect to those funds which carries on over and through
