

1 statutory or constitutional with respect to the
2 institutions of higher education as compared to the
3 secondary schools and the reason, primary reason that
4 comes to mind is the research and all that it carries
5 with it.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

8 MRS. BOTHE: I am a little quizzical as
9 to whether the Committee isn't sacrificing what was a
10 beautiful theory to which I subscribed wholeheartedly
11 to a practice which has turned out to be very effective
12 in the state. The Miscellaneous Provisions Committee,
13 in its report this morning and the sections which we
14 didn't have occasion to discuss make certain, or draws
15 certain conclusions about the present means of selection
16 of the Board of Education and the Superintendent of
17 Education and because that system was apparently
18 working so smoothly, our Committee felt it was unwise to
19 upset the apple cart by placing those offices in the
20 Constitution or in any other respect providing for
21 change. I don't know that the principles there would
