2 MR. MARTINEAU: That is correct. I think
3 you are in more trouble if you say by law, which means
4 he is appointed by the Legislature and then you are
5 really going to be in trouble.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

7 MR. POWER: I thought I might give the
8 results of some research we had done into the method
9 of selecting school superintendents in other states.
10 This is only a report of 45 states, the short time
11 we worked on it, we missed five but the research
12 indicates that 23 states the School Superintendent is
13 elected and in 19 states, the School Superintendent is
14 appointed by the Board and in 4 states presently the
15 School Superintendent is appointed by the Governor.

16 MR. MARTINEAU: I would like to ask a
17 question as to those figures.

20 where the School Superintendent is elected whether the
