seek to change the date. Everybody has had this date fixed on his calendar so long if we had a two-day session in the absence of a very strong request otherwise, we would probably say the third Monday and the next day.

Are there any questions as to this because I want to have you all understand it.

MR. MARTINEAU: If you had two separate days, would you plan to have them in the same week or one one week and one another week?

THE CHAIRMAN: If we had two separate days,
I would think they would be separated by not more than
two or three days. Otherwise, you lose momentum. A
week apart gains nothing.

MR. SAYRE: Would you seriously submit a weekend Saturday and Sunday?

THE CHAIRMAN: We will submit that too.
