simplification of what Mrs. Bothe and Mr. Gentry have said. For the first years of my appointment to the State Board of Public Welfare, the incumbent Governor had little to say over the welfare policies involving millions of dollars, had little to say over the policies of the department during the first term of his office. This is true in many other boards that are brought to our attention and again you are taking away the power of a strong executive. I can only say we have gone into it thoroughly and we got this from many, many people. The chaos we have had, instead of chaos you have, I believe, and gosh, I am not one for the spoils system, I believe you have a more efficient system of government.

MR. DELIA: The reason I raised the question before was because the Workmen's Compensation Commission is termed as a commission under Paragraph (b). As far as our judicial operation, it was put under Paragraph (c). There is no conflict there, it is all right because this is a twelve-year term of office and would mean the Covernor would not have an opportunity to make
