MRS.BOTHE: I can't seem to get from the 1 Committee just what the practical effect of this 2 proposal would be. Judge Adkins only a moment ago 3 expressed the belief that the Board of Regents of the 4 University of Maryland would not have been affected by 5 this proposal and subsequently stood corrected. I am 6 not at all clear in my mind as to which or what agencies 7 would be affected. There may be some of greater ន importance than the Board of Regents at the University 9 of Maryland or the State Superintendent of Schools. 10 They are the ones brought to mind and I don't see how 11 the Commission can make an intelligent vote on the under-12 lying principle involved here without knowing what the 13 factual effects will be and simply by making various 14 exceptions as we are now doing, I don't think meets 15 the objection and I don't see voting on it this way. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe, have you looked 17 at the schedule that is furnished? 18 MRS. BOTHE: Yes, I have and sitting next to 19 the reporter who told me not to look too far because I 20 wouldn't find the answer. 21
