

1 MR. POWER: Mrs. Bothe was inquiring as
2 to the facts of Subsection (b), that is one-half must
3 be subject to appointment by the Governor upon taking
4 office. This is not included in there. It is in some
5 other material but we don't have it here this afternoon.

6 MRS. BOTHE: No one seems to know which
7 agencies are regulatory and which are quasi-judicial
8 and the whole concept seems to be extremely uncertain.

9 MR. BROOKS: On the other hand, you might
10 add no matter what the present situation of agencies
11 are under the reorganization of the executive branch
12 it doesn't make a great deal of difference in that the
13 effect could be totally different from anything proven
14 on past experience.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, the
16 present investigation being made of the executive
17 department and the various agencies of the executive
18 department is not going to be completed until considerably
19 after we must have our report in, number one, and number
20 two, Mr. Brooks' point even if you knew today what the
21 situation would be, that might not be the situation after
