it is. Is there any further discussion as to this section or any further motion? Mr. Haile.

MR. HAILE: I have a thought that the Governor should also appoint the members of all boards or commissions in the administrative services except regulatory or quasi-judicial agencies. Whether they serve as head of the principal departments or not, I have an idea that the Governor should have the right to make those appointments and not leave that to the Legislature. Has the Committee considered that?

JUDGE ADKINS: Well, I would say yes.

We didn't feel it was necessary to provide that all
boards should be appointed by the Covernor. So boards
are appointed by the department, many advisory boards,
and boards of the penal institutions are appointed by
the Department of Welfare all under regulations prescribed
by the Legislature so we didn't think it necessary to
require that all boards be appointed, when talking about
the Governor. We are interested in what we call major
departments shall be subject to gubernatorial control.
