

1 been quite adequately stated. This is a prime require-
2 ment in our opinion if strong executive leadership is
3 to be furnished in Maryland. I am sorry that we have
4 not been able to answer Mrs. Bothe's questions relative
5 to the practical effect. A major constitutional
6 revision of this kind, cannot in my judgment ever be
7 forecast with accuracy. We can only say that all the
8 modern students of government that we have been able
9 to check have recommended that whatever the practical
10 effect is it will be a good one. I would hope that
11 the Commission would see fit to adopt and pass the
12 motion that has been presented.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Ready for the question?

14 The question arises on the motion to approve and adopt
15 Section 12 as amended in Subsections (a) and (b).

16 All in favor of the motion, please signify by a show
17 of hands, (a) and (c). Before you take the vote, I
18 omitted Dr. Burdette in stating the changes to mention
19 the change in (b) that Professor Power said would have
20 to be made merely to conform to (c).
