ladies and gentlemen, our report tomorrow morning will 1 deal with these broad areas. First, in the Seventh 2 Report you will notice that we have amended certain 3 sections in complete compliance with requests which you have made. This covers the first five pages and the 5 first paragraph on page six, so that in general tomorrow I shall read the underscored words in Sections 5, 7, 10, 13, 15, 16, and 17 which deal with require-8 ments on the part of Commission action at the last 9 meeting. Secondly, tomorrow we will deal with a highly 10 important recommendation on the part of this Committee 11. in respect to unicameralism versus bicameralism. 12 shall read our recommendation at this point and tomorrow 13 we will move one way or mother. By that majority of 14 one vote, the Committee recommends to the Commission the 15 adoption of a bicameral Legislature. The majority 16 recognizes that the case for unicameralism is almost 17 as strong but believes that Maryland should retain its 18 bicameral Legislature. If the Committee should take 19 action other than the Commission on bicameral Legislature, 20 we have prepared a text --21
