

1 ladies and gentlemen, our report tomorrow morning will  
2 deal with these broad areas. First, in the Seventh  
3 Report you will notice that we have amended certain  
4 sections in complete compliance with requests which you  
5 have made. This covers the first five pages and the  
6 first paragraph on page six, so that in general  
7 tomorrow I shall read the underscored words in Sections  
8 5, 7, 10, 13, 15, 16, and 17 which deal with require-  
9 ments on the part of Commission action at the last  
10 meeting. Secondly, tomorrow we will deal with a highly  
11 important recommendation on the part of this Committee  
12 in respect to unicameralism versus bicameralism. I  
13 shall read our recommendation at this point and tomorrow  
14 we will move one way or another. By that majority of  
15 one vote, the Committee recommends to the Commission the  
16 adoption of a bicameral Legislature. The majority  
17 recognizes that the case for unicameralism is almost  
18 as strong but believes that Maryland should retain its  
19 bicameral Legislature. If the Committee should take  
20 action other than the Commission on bicameral Legislature,
