

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Now, we will resume consideration  
2 of the Seventh Report of the Committee on the Legislative  
3 Department. Dr. Bard.

4 DR. BARD: You remember yesterday I had indicated  
5 Mr. Chairman, that there were three Roman Numerals, more or  
6 less, in terms of our presentation. I, A review of the  
7 recommendations that were made in terms of the Sixth Report  
8 and the changes which our Committee made thereof. II, A  
9 recommendation in terms of unicameralism versus bicameralism  
10 and III, A discussion of our memorandum.

11 It shall be our procedure to tie in our memoran-  
12 dum with a discussion of the Sections themselves, so that  
13 you might see the significance of our memorandum. We move,  
14 then, in terms of Section 5, which was the first Section  
15 that we had been asked to change at the time of the last  
16 Meeting of the Commission.

17 You will recall that in this particular Section  
18 we had been asked to add some words and the words appear on  
19 Page 2, in Special Session. The General Assembly shall by  
20 law enact a plan. We had not had those words in the Sixth  
21 Document, and also two lines from the bottom of the Section,
