3 tricting plans within a single plan.

4 DR. BARD: Yes, but there could be two and there
5 could be three, and this is why, I think, having the Style
6 Committee look at it, so it could be one or the other, is
7 in order.

8 MR. MILLER: Won't it be plans, in any case, be-
9 cause wouldn't the Governor have to submit -- they are on
10 entirely different principles -- I mean, they are on the
11 same principles, of course, but entirely different situa-
12 tions.

13 Maryland is allotted X number of congressmen and
14 it's got to be redistricted to fit that number, whether there
15 are more or less. Also, we have population changes within
16 our Legislature, and it seems to me that there might be,
17 if Maryland picked up or lost a congressman, there might be
18 plans rather than plan.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I think this is true, but
20 this we can leave to the Style Committee. I understand my
21 note and I don't think there's any trouble.
