2 MR. MILLER: Of each House.

3 DR. BARD: That's correct, of each house.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Now, Dr. Bard, let me interrupt.

5 This embodies a motion or request to reconsider two separate
6 matters, both pertaining to this Section, and I think under
7 our rules, since it is requested by the Committee, it will
8 be submitted to those present without debate and if the
9 motion is granted, then we would debate other matters.

10 The first question is whether we shall reconsider
11 the decision of the Commission on the issue of whether the
12 Legislature shall be a continuing body or whether it shall
13 convene for a stated number of days each year. This recom-
14 mendation was approved by the Commission in June. It was
15 rejected by a vote of 10 to 13 in July. It was not dis-
16 cussed in August. It was rejected in September. I do not
17 have the vote because we do not have the minutes. The ques-
18 tion on reconsideration is submitted without debate.

19 All those in favor of reconsideration of this
20 question at this time signify by a show of hands. Contrary?
21 The motion is carried nine to seven.
