3 MR. MARTINEAU: Or pass a law for --

4 DR. BARD: For that particular session.

5 MR. MARTINEAU: No, for every session. This, as
6 I recall, was one of the points that gained a lot of favor,
7 that they wouldn't go into each session without having any
8 idea when they would terminate, that they would know --

9 DR. BARD: Here it is. The General Assembly
10 shall be a continuous body meeting in regular annual sessions
11 commencing on the third Wednesday of January every year and
12 terminating as provided by law.

13 MR. MARTINEAU: Right. Is that your recommenda-
14 tion?

15 DR. BARD: That's my recommendation, as read now.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: That was changed to read, con-
17 tinuing body, instead of, continuous.

18 DR. BARD: Continuing body, that's correct.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion, Mr.
20 Martineau?
