

1 Legislature to convene itself.

2 In this respect, incidentally, the last time we
3 voted on the question, there was an absolute tie, and in
4 answer to Judge Adkins' point, in this respect, to my know-
5 ledge, and the Chairman might voice an opinion here, there
6 would be no requirement other than an additional sentence
7 in this one place and no other place.

8 My own feeling would be that in respect to
9 Section 7, which is before us now, I would feel more strongly
10 in regard to the second proposal which we will make by motion,
11 too, where there has been no vote, other than one tie vote,
12 than I would in regard to this one.

13 However, I do feel that certainly in theory and
14 in terms of argument and actuality, a Legislature faced
15 with a Constitutional deadline for adjournment may have a
16 spirit of action, but forced action, as we state here, is
17 often precipitous and unwise. So, I would tend to think that
18 this one, I would not have a strong feeling about this one
19 as I would about the other, also in terms of what this would
20 do to past action.
