think the article went on to state how this happens year after year after year, that wherever there is a Constitutional limitation on the session of the Legislature, there are continuous Constitutional Amendments changing these 4 terms around and the terms that were recited in there vary, 5 of course, from state to state; but the one thing that was 6 clear from the article was that no matter what figure was 7 chosen, there were Constitutional Amendments pending to 8 change them, and I think that only points up the weakness 9 of putting in such a limitation in the Constitution. 10 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Mr. Miller 11 you have spoken on the question, so has Mr. Della. 12 further discussion? Mr. Sykes? 13 I would like to ask a question. 14 MR. SYKES: wasn't on the Commission when any of this previous action 15 was taken. I was impressed just now by Congressman Miller's 16 point that the organization of the Legislature certainly
