them, regular sessions, special sessions of the Legislature and numerous other provisions that would make it necessary to go over it with a fine tooth comb.

In addition, I would feel that it was very unfortunate if, in the light of the previous votes, the one of -- I don't know the September vote, but 10 to 13, that is, rejected by 13 Members on one occasion and then the very closely allied proposition that the Legislative session be limited to 70 days passed by 16 to 9, if by a vote of any number of Members today less than that, either of those majorities, we reverse that position.

We are confronted with the necessity of finishing our task and it seems to me that if we allow ourselves to reconsider and change our position here, we necessarily must accord that privilege at the next Meeting of the Commission to the other Members.

I would personally feel that the previous action of the Commission on this issue should stand and that the report should carry in its body the text of an alternate provision providing for a continuing session, so that the Convention when it debates the matter anew, if it wished
