2 GOVERNOR LANE: Mr. Chairman, I think it would
3 be most unfortunate now for us to clash with what we have
4 already decided, knowing that would wreak more havoc. To
5 speak briefly, I agree with the Chairman, I agree with the
6 views he expressed, but I do think that the Legislature
7 should have the power under a certain vote to call itself
8 into session.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

10 DR. BARD: Mr. Chairman, I am deeply impressed
11 with the logic of your presentation and I would make this
12 point about the procedure. It is too bad we've come to
13 this wisdom about a continuing session rather late in life,
14 but I find this is true in life with me, as an individual
15 Member, as well as the Commission. I, therefore, withdraw
16 the motion with the strong appeal that we move favorably
17 in terms of the second motion which concerns itself with
18 the power to convene. I make this move with the hope that
19 I interpret properly the views of the Committee as a
20 whole, and I believe I do. Would that not be true?
