

1 Assembly has this particular power, it cannot carry out
2 some of the activities we discussed.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Ready
4 for the question?

5 MR. SAYRE: I have a question. The way this
6 motion reads is that you have to have three-fifths peti-
7 tioning the Governor to reconvene, is that right?

8 MR. MILLER: Three-fifths of the Members of each
9 House and then he must call it.

10 MR. SAYRE: Well, suppose that we meet 30 days.
11 I'm just thinking wouldn't it be easier for the Members to
12 vote by three-fifths to extend or re-extend for addi-
13 tional periods not to exceed 30 days each?

14 MR. MILLER: The unfortunate part about all of
15 that is, as Judge Adkins has pointed out, this would be a
16 special session. The only thing this would do, as I see
17 it, is to change what we have already begun, to the extent
18 that in addition to the Governor wanting to call it, he might
19 be made to call it, and that's the only thing we're adding
20 to the whole Constitution and I think it should be there
21 and it's very important.
