

1 MR. SAYRE: All right.

2 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion, Judge  
3 Adkins?

4 JUDGE ADKINS: I have to make the same point I  
5 made before, that I think this means each of the major Re-  
6 ports we adopted here have to be scanned and reviewed to  
7 make sure language would have to be changed. Language in  
8 my Report would have to be changed. The Executive veto is  
9 tied in and will have to be rewritten. That will have to  
10 be done.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't follow when you say the  
12 Executive veto is tied to two Sections?

13 JUDGE ADKINS: It's tied to the concept of the  
14 limited session. Now, if you give the Legislature the power  
15 to convene itself, the only thing you are doing is giving  
16 them a power to adopt a continuous session.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: No, this would be a special ses-  
18 sion and, therefore, I would think would tie in with the  
19 language of your Executive Department Report, would it not?

20 JUDGE ADKINS: I don't think it will, but I can't  
21 answer that without examining it in detail.
