

1           MR. MILLER: It would seem to me, Dale, that  
2 your Report provides for special session. The only thing  
3 this adds is that instead of the Governor calling it for  
4 himself, he calls it because he has received a petition,  
5 and I can't see how it would change any other Section that  
6 we've adopted. It's just another special session, that's  
7 all it is.

8           THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Are you  
9 ready for the question?

10           The question arises on the motion to add to the  
11 last sentence of Section 7, the phrase, And must convene  
12 the General Assembly in special session upon the written  
13 request of three-fifths of the Members of each House thereof.  
14 All those in favor, please signify by a show of hands.  
15 Contrary? The motion is carried 12 to five.

16           Now, still on Section 7.

17           DR. BARD: Still on Section 7. We have one more  
18 point and, herein, we don't feel as strongly. However, we  
19 would like to call your attention to this particular gap,  
20 as we see it, and that's point 3. The legislature should  
21 have a two-year term. The legislature, when convened,
