point to the Committee that these were serious gaps, as we 1 saw them, and in this case, I am not prepared to move, in 2 terms of 3 or 4, but rather to point to the Committee as 3 a whole that strong statements with reference to 3 and 4 4 need to be made either as alternative statements or as 5 recommendations for review to the Convention rather than 6 to this body. 7 THE CHAIRMAN: All right. Then, we'll go back 8 again to Section 7. 9 DR. BARD: Now, perhaps another Member of the 10 Committee may choose to make a motion in this respect. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe? 12 MRS. BOTHE: Was there a vote on this? I don't 13 recall when it was debated before. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: There is no motion before the 15 Commission. The question of staggered terms was rejected 16 in June by a vote of 15 to six. It was not considered in 17 July or August. It was rejected in September. I do not 18 19 have the vote. On the other one, Mr. Chairman, we 20 DR. BARD: never did have an extended debate on this --21
