

1 point to the Committee that these were serious gaps, as we
2 saw them, and in this case, I am not prepared to move, in
3 terms of 3 or 4, but rather to point to the Committee as
4 a whole that strong statements with reference to 3 and 4
5 need to be made either as alternative statements or as
6 recommendations for review to the Convention rather than
7 to this body.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: All right. Then, we'll go back
9 again to Section 7.

10 DR. BARD: Now, perhaps another Member of the
11 Committee may choose to make a motion in this respect.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Mrs. Bothe?

13 MRS. BOTHE: Was there a vote on this? I don't
14 recall when it was debated before.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: There is no motion before the
16 Commission. The question of staggered terms was rejected
17 in June by a vote of 15 to six. It was not considered in
18 July or August. It was rejected in September. I do not
19 have the vote.

20 DR. BARD: On the other one, Mr. Chairman, we
21 never did have an extended debate on this --
