THE CHAIRMAN: Let's go back to Section 7, before we move on to the other point.

DR. BARD:

that we have no other recommendation in this respect, unless a Member of this Commission feels that we ought to consider these two points together. We're merely pointing to the importance of calling these two issues to the attention of the Convention as a whole at this time.
