

1 former, that it could extend it to 30, if it felt the need  
2 and that, of course, goes back to our original belief of  
3 the Committee in a continuing session. However, there has  
4 been no interpretation, to my knowledge, by the Commission  
5 as a whole, Mr. Chairman.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: I think it's important to under-  
7 stand what the Commission desires on this point, because  
8 I think the language needs clarification and the Committee  
9 on Style ought to have the clarification.

10 MR. SCANLAN: I think I was the author of that.  
11 I certainly intended it would be for one period, which  
12 would be no longer than 30 days, but it could be shorter.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, if the Legislature  
14 approached the end of its 70-day session, it would have to  
15 make up its mind it was going to extend for ten or 20 or  
16 30 days and, whatever it did, it did once.

17 MR. SCANLAN: Right.

18 MR. MILLER: That would have to do with the  
19 regular session and not anything to do with this other  
20 provision.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: Right. Any dissent from that
