the protection you want.

For instance, in the memorandum on Page 2, there are a number of phrases that give some protection, none of which are quite what I had in mind. The closest is in 3, which says, The right of all persons to fair and just treatment in the course of legislative and executive investigation shall not be infringed. I would favor the addition of a phrase like that to this clause, rather than what I think is really less protection, the phrase, Germane to legislation pending.

Judge Adkins?

JUDGE ADKINS: I would simply like to say that
the purpose of my proposal here is precisely to protect
against what I consider to be the potential abuse that Mr.
Scanlan has insisted should be the right of the Legislature.
So, we have a direct confrontation on that point.
I think, under normal circumstances, the

Legislature of Maryland has not engaged too frequently in investigations prior to the introduction of legislation.

Normally speaking, hearings and investigations are carried out after some proposed legislation has been produced.
