THE CHAIRMAN: Judge Adkins? 1 JUDGE ADKINS: I have no further comment. 2 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Scanlan. 3 4 MR. SCANLAN: I want to say at this time, it's a pleasure to agree with Judge Adkins. 5 JUDGE ADKINS: Thank you. Your help is welcome. 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comments? 7 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Mr. Chairman, would it be in 8 order now, since there is a word here, to use the language 9 of lawyers. I want to know if the word, production, is a 10 11 word of art, because I think of production as manufacture. 12 THE CHAIRMAN: With lawyers in recent years, it 13 is indeed a word of art. 14 MR. FREEDLANDER: I just wondered whether it 15 would be better to use the Word, submission, because I think it means something other than production, as in 16 creating and producing. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: I think it's accurate and it does 18 have a meaning among lawyers to produce records. 19 I wonder if we could take a break at this time? 20 21 (There was a short recess.)
