2 exercising such power.

3 All those in favor signify by a show of hands.  
4 Contrary? The motion is carried, 11 to five.

5 Now, Judge Adkins, you have another motion on  
6 the same subject.

7 JUDGE ADKINS: I have one more and I'll quit.  
8 I would propose a new sentence be added immediately pre-  
9 ceding the last sentence of the paragraph and following  
10 the Amendment which we have just made which reads as fol-  
11 lows: The right of all persons to fair and just treatment  
12 in the course of Legislative and Executive investigations  
13 shall not be infringed.

14 MR. BOND: I second it.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any discussion? Mrs.  
16 Freedlander?

17 MRS. FREEDLANDER: Do we not already have such  
18 protection in the Declaration of Rights, as adopted?

19 THE CHAIRMAN: I would answer, if you have a  
20 provision in the Constitution in this paragraph conferring  
21 an express power, you would avoid -- to compel attendance
