MR. MARTINEAU: I think it should be really, ı. I don't know that there is anything that is 2 called a sitting at --3 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any objection 4 changing sitting to session? 5 MRS. FREEDLANDER: I have a question applicable 6 to the same point. The rules of the House of Delegates 7 and the Senate of the State of Maryland as they state now 8 already state this as part of the rules, that between sessions, 9 that between regular sessions Committees meet. I'm won-10 dering why it's necessary to put it in the Constitution? 11 In other words, that whole phrase, it seems to me, is un-12 necessary, if the rules of the House of Delegates indicate 13 it. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard? 15 DR. BARD: We did this at the behest of the 1ô Commission. If you remember, we had quite a discussion on 17 this point and the Commission made it very clear that they 18 felt it was necessary to do so. 19
