

1 MR. MARTINEAU: I think it should be really,
2 sessions. I don't know that there is anything that is
3 called a sitting at --

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any objection to
5 changing sitting to session?

6 MRS. FREEDLANDER: I have a question applicable
7 to the same point. The rules of the House of Delegates
8 and the Senate of the State of Maryland as they state now
9 already state this as part of the rules, that between sessions,
10 that between regular sessions Committees meet. I'm won-
11 dering why it's necessary to put it in the Constitution?
12 In other words, that whole phrase, it seems to me, is un-
13 necessary, if the rules of the House of Delegates indicate
14 it.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

16 DR. BARD: We did this at the behest of the
17 Commission. If you remember, we had quite a discussion on
18 this point and the Commission made it very clear that they
19 felt it was necessary to do so.
