but the language in this Section that we're now considering on the Legislative Department, if you strike out the words, Provided by law, would be that the House of Delegates shall have the sole power of impeachment in all cases, and it would seem to me to be perfectly clear that there would be a power to impeach Judges as well as the other methods of removal provided in the Judiciary Articles. That's what I wanted to have clear THE CHAIRMAN: somewhere, either in the Constitution or in our Report or in the record here, that it is the understanding and belief of the Commission that although this Section of Article III will remain the only specific provision of the Constitution relating to impeachment, and although there is no provision in proposed Article IV with reference to impeachment of Judges, it is not intended to remove the power of the Legislature to impeach Judges. Is there any dissent from that proposition? I take it that this Amendment would not in any way touch on that question or affect it. I have a question. Was the answer to

my question that all elected officials could be impeached?
