not say that is a complete answer. 1 It was thought at the time as MR. BROOKS: 2 provided by law calls, or rather, the phrase was added be-3 cause of the removal of a number of prior elected officials 4 from the Constitution, that it might be desirable and some 5 allowance might want to be made for the impeachment of some 6 of the appointed officials or officials chosen in manners 7 other than by General Election. 8 MR. HOFF: Well, I'm curious to know how far 9 this power of impeachment does go? I'm not familiar/ it. 10 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, I am not sure myself, and 11 your question is the one that is in my mind, I assume, and 12 that is, does the power of impeachment extend beyond elec-13 tive officers. I don't think we can answer that. I believe 14 it does, but --15 It does repeatedly on the Federal MR. MILLER: 16 level. 17 I think that's a question that we THE CHAIRMAN: 18 will have to research further and I should think the answer 19 would be fairly clear, if we can get it. Dr. Bard? 20
