3 would be open to Judicial interpretation. It would have
4 to be.

5 MR. BROOKS: Would it clear it by leaving it or
6 adding it? It doesn't say where the line is any more than
7 if we didn't have the line.

8 MR. MARTINEAU: But if you don't have something
9 in here, it may be an empty power.

10 MR. MILLER: Would adding all Civil officers --
11 shall have the power of impeachment of all Civil officers,
12 would that clarify it?

13 MR. SYKES: What about the Adjutant General?

14 MR. MINDEL: The model Constitution provides that
15 the Legislature may impeach the Governor, heads of principal
16 departments, judicial officers and such other other officers
17 of the State as may be made subject to impeachment by law.

18 MR. HOFF: Officers of the State would prohibit
19 the impeachment going down into local officers.
