

1 The Commission asked us to insert those words
2 just to protect it; and until the third calendar day after
3 introduction.

4 Now, I have an important item here, a final
5 statement.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: I had a note with reference to
7 Section 13 that I omitted to call to your attention, if you
8 will go back there a moment. The first line says, Each
9 House shall be the final judge. I wonder what is added by
10 the word, final, and I wonder if it isn't a trouble maker,
11 because it connotes that someone else is also preliminarily
12 a judge? Would there be any objection to deleting the word
13 final, in the first line of Section 13?

14 DR. BURDETTE: Why not sole, instead of final?

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Why not just, Shall be the judge?

16 MR. SYKES: Mr. Chairman, I think you might want
17 to eliminate any problems, as to whether or not there is
18 judicial review. In fact, even the word, final, in connec-
19 tion with administrative agencies does not eliminate judi-
20 cial review, but I think there is more of a chance, in
21 light of the general interpretation of Constitutional
