

1 business for an hour on a day when there most likely would
2 be full representation of the Commission Membership and we
3 should not try to resolve it now.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: I would like to suggest amending
5 that to the extent of saying at the next meeting.

6 MR. SYKES: Very well. That's what I meant.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

8 DR. BARD: I would agree with that, except that
9 I believe we ought to make note at this time of the recom-
10 mendation of the Committee because, unless we do, we'll be
11 going all the way back and moving in circles again. So
12 that it seems to me that if we do make note of our recom-
13 mendation, which at this point is a recommendation in favor
14 or bicameralism, we would then have something to hinge our
15 debate onto.

16 This is all we're saying. I'm not asking now
17 that the Commission as a whole vote on the recommendation.
18 I am asking that you call attention to it, and finally, I
19 would like to have John say just a word or two about this
20 exhibit which was handed out within the last two or three
21 minutes.
