passed 183 bills carried to them from the Senate without any alteration at all. Review Index One indicates that only a grammatical change of some kind or other has been

only a grammatical change of some kind or other has been made in the bills enacted that have been sent to the House

made in the bills enacted that have been sent to the house
from the Senate. Review Index Two indicates minor sub-

stantive change. Review Index Three indicates some major overhaul, a real significant policy alteration in the legislation as it arrived from the Senate, and Conference

Committees have those bills referred out to Conference.

There is one problem, there's an immediate dis-

number in the Senate and Committee, but one got lost somewhere. There is one other thing that should be called to your attention that could be a significant factor that is not reflected here, which is the question of how many of the bills were precisely the same at the time they were introduced in the House and the Senate and that will be taken into account at a later time, but at this point we don't have sufficient statistics to indicate that on this
