that the same privilege be extended to vote on other 1 matters. I think it's rough that we have to do this, but 2 I really feel that it would be most unwise to provide at 3 this late date for absentee voting. You never know what 4 comes up in debate. 5 MR. MARTINEAU: Mr. Chairman, may I suggest that 6 if you don't permit them to vote, that I think the record 7 ought to indicate the feelings of those people who are ab-8 sent? 9 THE CHAIRMAN: No difficulty about doing this at 10 a11. 11 MR. BOND: May I suggest that the convening time 12 not be set at 9 o'clock next Monday morning? 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Would 8:30 be better? 14 MR. BOND: I just suspect it's going to be pretty 15 hard for everybody to get there by 9. 16 THE CHAIRMAN: It's up around Elkton. We'll 17 have to find out how far it is for the furthest Member and 18 work a convenient time. We'll try to work it so no one 19 has to arise earlier than 5 a.m. that morning. 20 (The Meeting adjourned at 12 noon.) 21
