

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Next is the report of the
2 Executive Director.

3 MR. BROOKS: No report.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: I have just a very few things
5 to mention. First, I want to let all of you know that
6 Clarence Miles continues to improve. Mrs. Miles said
7 that if he continues at this rate, he will go home some-
8 time this coming week, the latter part of the week. He

11 for gall bladder which they found had become dangerous
