

1 division of that Committee have always been very close,
2 almost in an even division. Presumably the Commission
3 would divide in somewhat the same way, and I ask this,
4 that you discuss and give some thought to that at lunch-
5 time so that the debate which will make up the record
6 on this issue to go to the Convention will be meaningful,
7 and if you give some thought ahead of time to just what
8 you are going to say and make your point concisely and
9 briefly.

10 The third matter will be the Report of the
11 Committee on Political Subdivisions. This will be a
12 lengthy report. It involves not one, but a number of
13 very important policies. This Report deals with one of
14 the most difficult and troublesome areas of Constitution-
15 making which the Commission faces, and I want to remind
16 you now just of a few of the decisions that the Commis-
17 sion has heretofore made and some of the problems that
18 will be presented to you in connection with that Report
19 so that you can be giving some thought about those, too.
