

1 would strike me as being subject to the interpretation
2 under our new Constitution that the Governor and Lieu-
3 tenant Governor, elected representatives of the people, could
4 exercise the taxing power under doctrines that have
5 developed in the Federal Government that the President of
6 the United States is the most representative of all the
7 elected officers. I am not sure, that is the first part
8 of the question -- the second part is whether or not
9 this is intended to mean below the State level and at
10 the local level so that boards, well, even at the State,
11 even the State or local level, that boards elected by
12 the General Assembly, if there are such later created
13 could be given the taxing power and if local boards be-
14 ing elected by representative bodies could receive the
15 taxing power.

16 MR. CASE: The answer to your questions in the
17 inverse order the way you presented them are that first,
18 boards which are appointed by the Legislature are not
19 elected representatives of the people and would not have
20 the taxing power and this provision, as I tried to ex-
21 plain a few minutes ago, is directed expressly at this
very thing, that only the elected representatives of the
